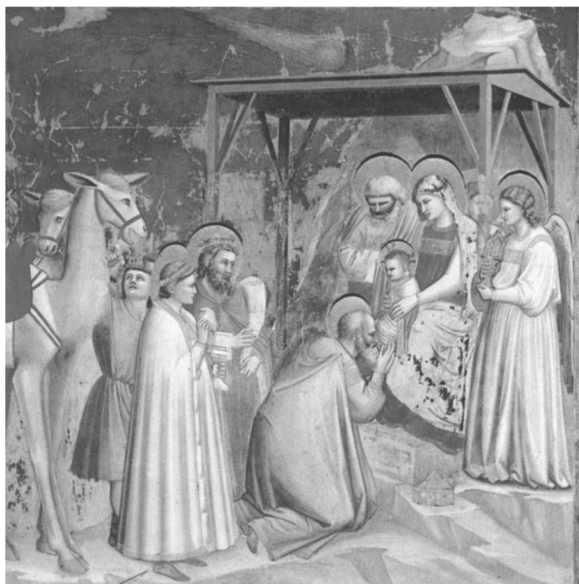

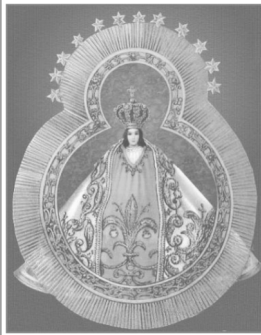

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Each January we remember in a special way our responsibility to love and protect all persons, especially the most vulnerable. In exercising this responsibility, please consider participating in one or more of the events described below as an opportunity to witness to the dignity of human life.

1. The sixth annual *Love My Life Youth Rally* will be held on January 16, 2016, at 10:00 am in a heated tent on the Halifax Mall in downtown Raleigh. Last year, over 1000 youth joined us for this event. Following the *Rally* at noon, adults and families are invited to join our youth in the same venue for our *Diocesan Mass for Life*, for which I will serve as the Principal Celebrant and Homilist. The *North Carolina March for Life* will then occur directly after Mass, when we will join people from throughout our State in peaceful witness to the sanctity of human life and the protection of the unborn.
2. *Nine Days of Prayer, Penance and Pilgrimage*, an initiative of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, begins on January 16, 2016 in advance of the *National March for Life* and concluding with the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul on January 25, 2016. Information on these days will be made available to you, so you may participate in prayer toward building a culture of life, where the precious gift of human life is protected and nurtured always.
3. Please join me at the *North Carolina Mass for Life* at 11:30 am on Friday, January 22, 2016, at the Basilica Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC. Bishop Peter Jugis will serve as the Principal Celebrant for the Mass and I will be offering the homily. Following the Mass, Bishop Jugis and I will join hundreds of thousands of people from North Carolina and across the country to offer witness to the sanctity of all human life as we participate in the *National March for Life*.

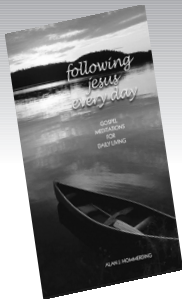
