In 2008, we established Catholic Voice North Carolina (CVNC) and the website [www.CatholicVoiceNC.org](http://www.CatholicVoiceNC.org) to provide nonpartisan information on public policy matters that intersect with Catholic teaching, values, and morality, as well as to give Catholics a way to voice their opinions directly to elected officials. Today, Catholic Voice North Carolina has more than 5,000 participants. We write this letter in the hope that more Catholics in the Diocese of Raleigh and the Diocese of Charlotte will sign up to become CVNC participants. Your voice should be heard!

As a CVNC participant you will receive CVNC e-mail alerts which share the Church's moral and social teaching on public policy matters. These alerts often include a request for advocacy to defend life and promote the common good. At times, this includes a request to contact your elected leaders. Public policy research has shown that the decisions of legislators are affected by direct contact by their constituents.
