

Synod of Bishops will begin in the local Churches

In October, Pope Francis will open a three-year synodal journey with three phases (diocesan, continental, universal) of consultations and discernment, culminating with the assembly in October 2023 in Rome.

"One listening to the others; and all listening to the Holy Spirit."

To make the synodality desired by Pope Francis since the beginning of his pontificate concrete and visible, the next Synod of Bishops, scheduled for October 2023, will not only be celebrated in the Vatican but in each particular Church of the five continents, following a three-year itinerary divided into three phases: diocesan, continental and universal.

A decentralised Synod

The Synod was conceived by Pope Paul VI as a way to continue the collegial experience of the Second Vatican Council. During the ceremonies commemorating the 50th anniversary of the institution of the Synod of Bishops, Pope Francis expressed his desire for a common path for "laity, pastors, the Bishop of Rome." Now, for the first time, a "decentralised" Synod is being celebrated.

Diocesan phase: consultation and participation of the People of God

The objective of this phase is the consultation of the People of God. To this end, the Secretariat of the Synod will send a preparatory Document accompanied by a Questionnaire and a Vademecum with proposals for carrying out the consultation in each particular Church.

Continental phase: dialogue and discernment

This will mark the beginning of the second, continental phase, scheduled to take place from September 2022 to March 2023.

The aim is to engage in a dialogue on the *Instrumentum laboris*. At the end of the their discussions, each continental grouping will draft a final document, which they will send to the General Secretariat in March 2023.

Universal phase: the bishops of the world in Rome

The synodal journey will culminate in October 2023 with the celebration of the Assembly of Bishops in Rome, according to the renewed procedures established in 2018 by Pope Francis in the Constitution [Episcopalis communio](#).



¿Qué es el Sinodo de los Obispos?

El Sínodo de los Obispos es el órgano (instituto eclesiástico) permanente de la Iglesia que mantiene el espíritu de colegialidad surgido a partir del Concilio Vaticano II.

[El Sínodo de Obispos fue creado por Pablo VI en 1965](#). Sus objetivos son: fomentar la unión entre el Papa y los Obispos, facilitar el conocimiento de la situación de la Iglesia en el mundo actual y fomentar la concordancia de opiniones.

El XVI Sínodo de los Obispos tiene por tema “Por una Iglesia sinodal: comunión, participación y misión” y tras la reorganización aprobada por el papa el pasado mayo consistirá en un proceso de casi tres años para dar voz a las diócesis y los fieles.

Así, el papa pidió que el Sínodo no sea “**una convención eclesial, una conferencia de estudios o un congreso político sino un acontecimiento de gracia, un proceso de sanación guiado por el Espíritu Santo.**”

“El Espíritu nos pide que nos pongamos a la escucha de las preguntas, de los afanes, de las esperanzas de cada Iglesia, de cada pueblo y nación. Y también a la escucha del mundo, de los desafíos y los cambios que nos pone delante. No insonoricemos el corazón, no nos blindemos dentro de nuestras certezas”, instó.

“Dios no habita en lugares asépticos y tranquilos, lejos de la realidad, sino que camina a nuestro lado y nos alcanza allí donde estemos, en las rutas a veces ásperas de la vida”, recordó el pontífice ante el clero reunido en la basílica de San Pedro.

Tras esta apertura, se pasará a una fase de consulta de los fieles hasta abril de 2022, enviando un cuestionario a cada diócesis, mientras que en septiembre de ese año y hasta marzo de 2023 se planteará las mismas cuestiones a nivel continental.

La Asamblea General del Sínodo se reunirá en octubre de 2023 en el Vaticano para estudiar y debatir toda la información recabada e integrada en el conocido como “Instrumentum Laboris”, un documento de trabajo.
