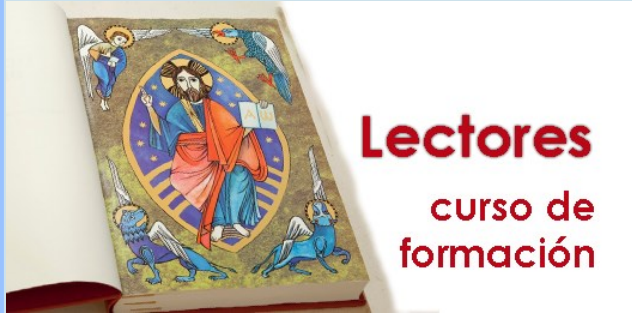

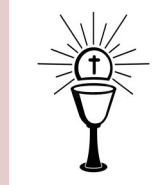

Parish Council Meeting

June 28, 2022

1. The Finance Council reported that we are presently solvent solely on the basis of offertory collections and donations that have been received. We concluded the fiscal year with a surplus budget.
2. New Carpeting for Church: The parish has submitted a request from the Diocese for a partial grant (\$5000) to defray the cost of new carpeting for the church in the new fiscal year. We have received an estimate from Kivett's, Inc., the manufacturer of our pews and the company that first installed them, and are awaiting another at present.
3. The Diocese of Raleigh has issued a document to ensure basic physical security measures that should be in effect in each parish in the near future. For a parish of our size, they suggest that we name a Security Administrator. Candidates were discussed and one has been selected as the obvious choice for this position.



4. There will be two fundraising events in the late summer/early fall period. The first will take place on Saturday, September 17, in the left-side parking lot of the church. It is the annual *Día de la Independencia* of the Hispanic community. On the last Saturday of October (29th) we will celebrate the Gala as we once did, but now with a masquerading element.

5. There will be elections for a new Parish Council sometime in October. The new Council will have six members from the Anglo community, and six more from the Hispanic community. More details of the procedure to be followed will be explained to once we draw nearer to that time.
