Luis Rafael Zarama, J.C.L., Bishop of Raleigh



En respuesta al llamado del Santo Padre Papa Francisco, el obispo Luis Rafael Zarama ha abierto un proceso de escucha diocesana durante la semana previa a la Navidad. Los pasos dados por el Obispo Luis siguen al reciente anuncio del Santo Padre Papa Francisco de un proceso de preparación de dos años para la XVI Asamblea General Ordinaria del Sínodo de los Obispos 2023, bajo el título rector, "Por una Iglesia Sinodal: Comunión, Participación y Misión".

El Obispo Luis eligió comenzar formalmente el viaje sinodal de la Diócesis de Raleigh durante la semana de Navidad mediante el lanzamiento de una [encuesta en línea](#), que será seguida por sesiones de escucha en persona en toda la diócesis. Explicó: "La Navidad es un tiempo en el que Dios envió a su Hijo para estar entre nosotros. Dios mismo buscaba escucharnos y ser parte de nuestra historia y ayudarnos en nuestro viaje".

Si bien el término "[sinodo](#)" no es familiar para la mayoría de los católicos, tiene sus raíces en griego, que significa "caminar con" o "viajar juntos". Cada diócesis católica en todo el mundo está siendo llamada a crear oportunidades para escuchar y dialogar a nivel parroquial y diocesano. Los procesos implementados en cada diócesis serán seguidos por discusiones nacionales y regionales que conducirán al Sínodo mismo, que tendrá lugar en Roma en 2023.

"El Santo Padre está buscando escuchar a toda la Iglesia", explicó el obispo Luis. "Escuchando y trabajando juntos para llevar la Buena Nueva del Evangelio a toda la Iglesia y al mundo".

Todos en la diócesis, incluidos aquellos que ya no están afiliados a la Iglesia, aquellos de otras religiones, o ninguna fe en particular, están invitados a proporcionar sus pensamientos con respecto a la Comunión, la Participación y la Misión en la Iglesia. Se utilizará [un cuestionario electrónico en internet](#) para recopilar información y emitir invitaciones seleccionadas al azar a aquellos que también están abiertos a asistir a sesiones de escucha y diálogo en persona a principios de 2022.

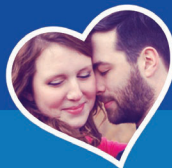
